GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

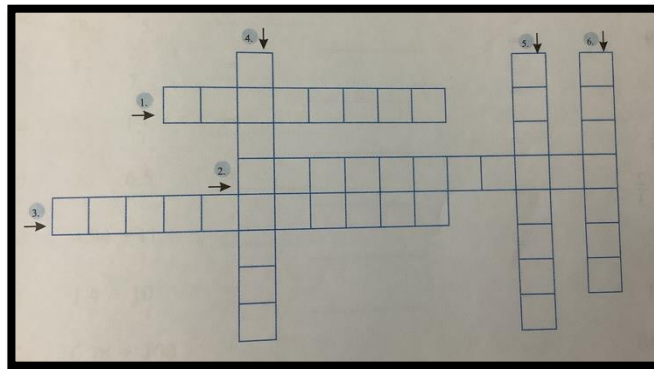
- 1. Complete the work (C.W./H.W.) of all the subjects taught in the class, in the respective notebook and in Neat and Clean Handwriting, if still pending.**

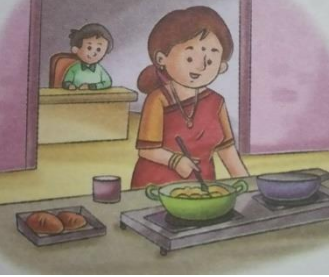
